God's response:

Exodus 33:19-22 "And the Lord said, 'I will cause ALL my goodness to pass in front of you, and I will proclaim my name, the Lord, in your presence. I will have mercy on whom I will have mercy, and I will have compassion on whom I will have compassion. But, he said, you cannot see my face, for no one may see me and live."

God's accommodation for Moses:

Exodus 33:21-23. "Then the Lord said, 'There is a place near me where you may stand on a rock. When my glory passes by, I will put you in a cleft in the rock and cover you with my hand until I have passed by. Then I will remove my hand and you will see my **back**, but my face must not be seen."

MOSES' PRAYER

Exodus 33:7 & 11 "Now Moses used to take a tent and pitch it outside the camp some distance away, calling it the "tent of meeting." ... **The Lord would speak to Moses face to face, as a man speaks with his friend.** Then Moses would return to the camp."

Exodus 33:12-13 "Moses said to the Lord, 'You have been telling me, 'Lead these people,' but you have not let me know whom you will send with me. You have said, 'I know you by name and you have found favor in me.' **If you are pleased with me, teach me your ways so that I may know you and continue to find favor with you.**"

Exodus 33:14-17 "The Lord replied, My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest. Then Moses said to him, If your Presence does not go with us, do not send us up from here. And the Lord said to Moses, 'I will do the very thing you have asked, because I am pleased with you and I know you by name.'
